MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF RUDSTON PARISH COUNCIL HELD IN THE VILLAGE HALL ON WEDNESDAY 8 JULY 2026 AT 19:30PM

1. APOLOGIES

Apologies received from Cllrs. Rhodes and Matthews.

2. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

No declarations of interest declared.

3. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

RESOLVED: All in favour that the minutes of the meeting held Wednesday 13 May 2026 are signed as a true record of the meeting's decisions.

4. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

Cllr. Carol Bliss of Burton Agnes Parish Council shared information from the recent Extraordinary Meeting of Burton Agnes Parish Council, where councillors agreed a resolution on the level of community benefit funding that should be sought from Ridge Clean Energy. The Chair of Rudston Parish Council was provided with copies of the meeting notes and draft minutes.

6.1 Planning Applications:

6.3 Ridge Clean Energy Community Fund

Warcup proposed a further informal meeting with all 3 councils involved but no vote was held. Cllr. Owen offered to enquire with ERYC Planning Department about the current status of the application.

RESOLVED: Agreed a meeting with 2 councillors and Tom Clay of ERNLLCA would be useful to discuss the governance of the playing field and pavilion. Clerk to arrange meeting at a mutually convenient time.

RESOLVED: Agreed for Clerk to arrange for a Wednesday evening at the village hall at a mutually convenient time.

RESOLVED: All in agreement for Cllr. Ackroyd's proposal to arrange a group photo.

13. COUNCILLORS' REPORTS – VILLAGE ISSUES

- Cllr. Todd has been made aware that the Gypsy Race is being dug out and questioned if permission is needed. The general consensus was that permission would be needed from riparian landowners and ERYC.
- Cllr. Wood reported: the hedge between the play park and East Gate is overgrown; ERYC are not cutting the grass near Redgate Garage on Middle Street and requested that this be added to the next meeting agenda; the hedge on Long Street from the bus shelter towards High Street is overgrown.
- Cllr. Warcup wished to congratulate Cllr. Wood for arranging the replacement of 2 new street signs on East Gate.

14. CLERK'S UPDATE AND CORRESPONDENCE RECEIVED

- The Clerk advised that Unit 4 of CiLCA has now been passed and there is 1 unit remaining to complete.
